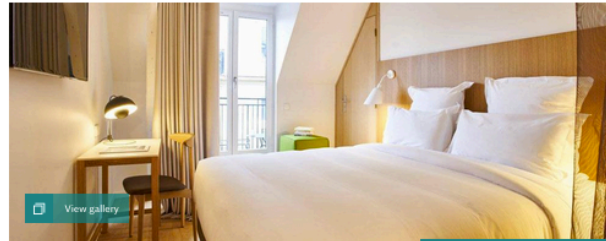

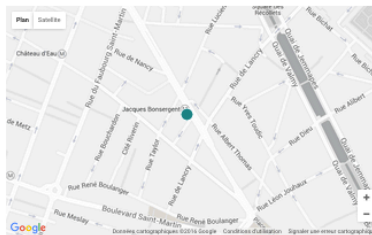

7/10 Location

République is the third 9Hotel to open in Paris, and, like its Opéra and Montparnasse counterparts, is located off the main tourist strip. Situated in the trendy 10e, the hotel is less than five minutes' walk from the Canal St Martin, with its diverse hipster restaurants and laid-back bars. The chic Marais district, Louvre and Tuilleries gardens, as well as the Gare du Nord for domestic and international rail services, including Eurostar, are also all within walking distance. Nearest metros: Jacques Bonsergent and République.



8/10 Style & character

The exterior of this mid 19th-century building is classic Paris Haussmann - but there are few indicators of the hotel's age once you're inside, save pleasing hints by way of high ceilings and French windows. Décor is the very definition of clean and contemporary - oak floors, white walls and Scandi-style furnishings, but small details prevent the space from feeling too utilitarian; well-stocked bookshelves, hand-picked day and night playlists in the lobby and - my personal favourite, diffused throughout - a subtle ambient perfume created just for the hotel.

7/10 Service & facilities

Staff were polite, helpful and discreet. There is a well-equipped gym and a 'co-working' area with plug sockets and printers. Guests are invited to make use of it and the hotel management also encourage local businesses to work and meet in the lobby at no charge.

8/10 Rooms

The minimalist rooms offer a surprising level of comfort: beds are outstandingly good - the result is a rest so pleasing you might be forgiven for lingering a bit longer than you ought in the morning. Bathrooms are a particular treat, equipped with rain showers, underfloor heating and the fluffiest of robes. Single rooms are also available.

7/10 Food & drink

The breakfast buffet, served in a stylish underground space, is self-service (guests even boil their own eggs, which may not be to everyone's taste, but staff are on hand to assist and replenish for choice). There is no restaurant (though you will be spoiled for choice by the offerings lining the nearby canal). The self-service bar stocks organic French wine and is open 24 hours - guests swipe their room card to dispense the drink and the price is added to their bill.

7/10 Value for money

Classic room (standard double) from €109 (£85) in low season; rising to €263 (£204) in high. Single rooms from €88 (£69) in low season; rising to €212 (£164) in high. Breakfast not included - priced at 15€ (£12). Free Wi-Fi.
